 - will set up **mandatory** Emission Limit Values
 - mandatory for all facilities to comply with within 4 years
 - mandatory for all facilities in the EU and the EEA
 - oan affect environmental requirements globally
- If the Fishmeal Industry wants to influence the BAT conclusion
 - active (and comprehensive) action is needed
 - early action is necessary

Proposed Action (1)

Prior to kick-off meeting in TWG

"Provide a preliminary overview on the relevant environmental issues in the Fishmeal industry":

Action	Amount of time
Benchmark of environmental performance of facilities of EU Fishmeal member facilities	8 days
Clarification of specific areas of concern	7 days
Synthetization of data for presentation at TWG Kick- off meeting	5 days



Proposed Action (2)

Prior to kick-off meeting in TWG

Benchmark of environmental performance of facilities of EU Fishmeal member facilities

- NIRAS prepares a questionnaire on
 - Technology applied
 - Environmental performance
 - Nature of surroundings
- NIRAS prepares a request for receipt of environmental permits
- Marine Ingredience distibute questionnaire to all facilities



Proposed Action (3)

Prior to kick-off meeting in TWG

Clarification of specific areas of concern

- NIRAS compares the environmental performance of the individual facility with the nature of the surroundings, the technical capability and the environmental regulation
- Based on the comparison potential areas of concern are identified

The more data, the better clarification.

Benchmarking will not be better than the quantity of responses from the members.



Proposed Action (4)

Prior to kick-off meeting in TWG

Synthetization of data for presentation at TWG Kick-off meeting

NIRAS prepares a presentation of the results of the benchmark analysis.

The presentation will include specific recommendations on the upcomming data collection process – including

- which data is relevant
- which data should not be considered
- possibly examples on wording of specific questions



Proposed Action (5)

After kick-off meeting

"The EU Fishmeal provides assistance to its members aiming at easing the collection and communication of data from the individual facilities."

Action

Assitance to individual facilities on collection and communication of data

Interpretation of collected data and communication to the EIPPCB

The amount of time of assistance is expected to be approximately 1 day / week from the kick-off meeting until the the BREF document is ready.



Proposed Action (6)

During drafting of BREF

"The Fishmeal industry actively ensures collection of data illustrating the conditions in the Fishmeal industry – and actively ensures correct interpretation of these data"

Action

Detailed review of first draft

Detailed review of proposed amendments and revised draft

Formulation of proposed amendments on behalf of the EU Fishmeal industry

Participation in TWG meetings when relevant

Participation in Article 13 Forum meetings when relevant
