Working groups of the Aquaculture Advisory Council

- Fish Working Group
- Shellfish Working Group
- General Issues Working Group

<u>Rules and statutes that define working groups (sub-groups may be formed upon agreement by the Executive Committee, following the same rules and statutes):</u>

- 1. Working Groups may be established in order to prepare deliberations on specific questions.
- 2. The Executive Committee creates Working Groups with a specific scope and area of interest.
- 3. The number, nature and composition of Working Groups is covered in the Rules of Procedure. Specific mandates or rules and budgets must be approved by the Executive Committee.
- 4. The Executive Committee may establish Working Groups to assist it in its tasks. Working Groups may be ad hoc, appointed for a specific purpose for a limited duration, or may be permanent.
- 5. The Executive Committee will define the scope and rules for Working Groups and request proposals for participation from members of the General Assembly, and appoints them.
- 6. A Chair for each Working Group will be appointed from members of that Working Group and/or Executive Committee,
- 7. Each Working Group Chair will be responsible for communicating positions, deliberations and advice of that Working Group to the Executive Committee.
- 8. Deliberations put forward by the Working Groups shall be examined for approval by the Executive Committee.
- 9. Working Group Meetings and other consultation actions will be made under the same conditions as those that apply to the Executive Committee.
